

Equipment

A good backpack is helpful and for routes in alpine terrain, a hat, gloves, a warm jacket and trousers are part of the basic equipment.

Waterproof shoes with non-slip soles, sunglasses, sun protection, and sufficient first aids are essential. A charged phone, torch, maps, knife and a small first-aid kit should also be part of it.

For multi-day hikes we suggest a backpack with a capacity of around 40 litres.



Water - Hikes

Talbachklamm & Upper Talbach Trail B2

Schladming 🕒 1:20 h ↔️ 4.6 km ⬆️ 110 vm ■ easy

Starting point: Kratter car park

In Talbachklamm, you will hike along a wide, beautiful path through the gorge with the rushing waters of the Talbach as your constant companion. Don't overlook the viewing platform above the Talbach at the beginning of the gorge. An attractive option for your way back is the route via the Upper Talbach Trail. However, plan a walking time of 1:30h, 4.9km and 165hm for it. This route is moderately difficult and not suitable for children.

Silberkarklamm B2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 2:30 h ↔️ 5.4 km ⬆️ 340 vm ■ moderate

A hike filled with variety leads you via steps and stairs along cascading waters and steep, towering cliffs, initially uphill through the gorge. Revealing itself at the end of the gorge is an imposing open circle, from where you will reach the Silberkarklamm in about 20 minutes. Return either through the gorge itself or for experienced, surefooted hikers, along the Höhenweg (Wurzelsteig) back to your starting point.

Family - Hikes & Themed-Walks

Bachalm B2

Ramsau, Filzmoos 🕒 2:20 h ↔️ 5.7 km ⬆️ 370 vm ■ moderate

The Bachalm is a popular excursion destination in the area of the Dachstein. You can choose between forest trails or forestry lanes. Having arrived at your destination you will be greeted, not only by a pleasant refreshment stop, but also – in all likelihood – a colony of marmots that make their home here.

Rittsberg Summit-Cross B1

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:30 h ↔️ 5.1 km ⬆️ 120 vm ■ easy

On the Gipeflurwändervweg, you will walk southeast past the Rittitsstadi and follow signs for the "Gipekrenz" (summit cross). The summit cross as well as the lookout tower are located at 1582m, treating you to breathtaking views of the Dachstein massif, Hochkarn and Grossglockner. Children discover an absolute paradise that includes a mountain playground, the "Grose" theme path and a barefoot path.

Rittsberg Circular-Trail B3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 3:30 h ↔️ 11.9 km ⬆️ 400 vm ■ moderate

This hike is for the whole family, in practically any weather. Awaiting you along this wide, pram-friendly path are the 400-year-old Haleralm as well as many other huts, some with petting zoos. You will also get great pleasures out of the Barefoot Path on the Rittitsstadi or the mountain playground.



Rittsberg Fairy-Tale-Trail A3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:15 h ↔️ 2.4 km ⬆️ 315 vm ■ easy

The FairyTale Path on the Rittsberg is a magical hike for the whole family. A newly created forest path leads to the Rittitsstadi. Along the way, various fairytale stations promise great entertainment. Little guests should pay close attention to each of the stations – since a special surprise awaits at the Rittitsstadi.

Roseggersteig B2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 2:45 h ↔️ 5.8 km ⬆️ 400 vm ■ moderate

From Gasthof Edelbrunn, the Roseggersteig takes you, occasionally via steep forest paths, up to the Brandriedel. There, you are greeted by a beautiful area of larch trees and an astonishing view of the Dachstein massif. You will now hike briefly downhill via the Austrühütte to the Brandriedl. At that point, a wide forestry lane leads back to the original starting point.

Sattelberg Nature-Trail C3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 2:15 h ↔️ 4.5 km ⬆️ 220 vm ■ easy

The first Nature & Ecology Path in Austria is a fascinating, instructive attraction for big and small explorers. In around three hours, the path will take you through somewhat steep terrain with exposed rocks to the summit of the Sattelberg, then downhill through occasionally hilly forests. A short section as far as the Sattelbergütte is also possible with a pushchair. At different stations along the way, you can learn interesting facts about nature in the area.

Lärchbodenaalm B2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:30 h ↔️ 4.0 km ⬆️ 310 vm ■ easy

Starting point: Hotel Feistner car park

A beautiful, relatively short hike to the Lärchbodenaalm at 1440m altitude. Mostly, you will be on a forestry lane that climbs steadily, leading through a beautiful mountain forest. After just one hour, you will come to a charming forest clearing, the site of the Lärchbodenaalm, an inviting opportunity for refreshments.

Reconstruction of the cable cars Senderbahn Hauser Kaibling and Mitterhausalm 1

Due to the construction of new cable car facilities during the summer season of 2025, there may be partial route diversions or closures, meaning that certain routes are not accessible or passable as usual. Please follow the signposting on site.

Panorama-Walks

Mountain-Tour to the Bärfallspitze D4

Haus 🕒 4:00 h ↔️ 7.3 km ⬆️ 600 vm ■ moderate

On this mountain tour, you extend the Schachen circular-trail on the Hauser Kaibling with a magnificent summit ascent. Following in the footsteps of the herd of sheep from Hauser Kaibling, you hike along well-trodden, alpine paths and gain more and more altitude before reaching the summit of the Bärfallspitze at 2150 metres.

Maram Circular-Trail A2

Ramsau, Filzmoos 🕒 3:40 h ↔️ 9.9 km ⬆️ 670 vm ■ easy

The Maram Circular Trail takes you on a hike along the border between Styria and Salzburg. A pleasant mountain road first brings you to the Schladfalm where, with a little bit of patience, you might encounter some marmots. You now continue through alpine pastures and a larch forest to the Dachstein road, before hiking down through forests and pastures to the Dachsteinruhe.

Ritts Panorama-Trail A3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:30 h ↔️ 5.3 km ⬆️ 130 vm ■ easy

Overcome by great panoramas, this hike takes you around the summit of the Rittsberg. There are essentially no vertical metres to overcome since you begin at the mountain station of the Rittsberg gondola. From there you hike westwards past the Rittsberg summit and lookout tower and can marvel at the Dachstein south faces from several vantage points or enjoy the far-reaching views of the Ennstal Valley.

Südwandhütte A2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:15 h ↔️ 3.1 km ⬆️ 220 vm ■ moderate

The Südwandhütte stands in an impressive location directly below the mighty walls of the Dachstein massif. On a no-less-impressive tour, you can hike out to this popular hikers' refuge. From the valley station of the Dachstein gondola, a narrow gravel path leads uphill. After barely one hour, you will have reached your goal.

5-Huts-Hike B2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 7:00 h ↔️ 19.0 km ⬆️ 830 vm ■ moderate

This hike leads you to five of the most beautiful areas of alpine pastures on the Ramsau plateau. Beginning at Gasthof Edelbrunn, you will hike through meadows, fields and high forests. Tip: This hike can also be combined with the bus ("Dachstein Seilbahn"). Amid the alpine pastures, you will be greeted by multiple huts offering opportunities for rest and refreshments.

Kufstein Summit D2

Haus 🕒 7:15 h ↔️ 14.0 km ⬆️ 1,250 vm ■ difficult

This long, though quite magical hike should only be attempted in good weather. Surrounded by a beautiful mixed forest, you will set out from Gasthof Burgstaller in the direction of the Stornalm. You will make a steep climb, with the vegetation gradually dominated by larch trees, especially in the area of the Gørg Wand. Upon reaching the summit cross, you will be greeted by a glorious 360° panorama.



Short Walks and Leisurely Tours

Valleys Circular Trail A4

Schladming 🕒 2:00 h ↔️ 6.5 km ⬆️ 160 vm ■ easy

During this beautiful walking tour, you will discover several small idyllic villages along the sunny side of the Ennstal. Hugging the forest's edge you will hike via Gleining, Pichl, Grubdorf, Warterdorf and Austdorf. Each village captivates with its own unique appearance, character and charm.

Pichl Circular-Trail A4

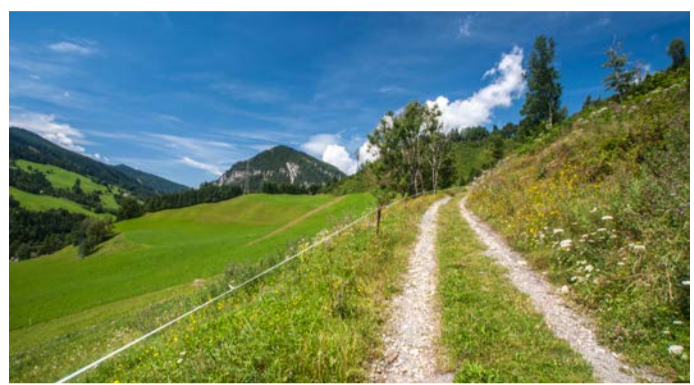
Schladming 🕒 3:30 h ↔️ 12.0 km ⬆️ 380 vm ■ easy

This hike links the small villages that make up Pichl, mostly along pleasant forest and meadow paths. Beginning in Gleiming, the Pichl Circular-Trail first follows the river Enns as far as the western district of Schladming "Obere Klaus". From there, it continues through the communities of Pichl, Grubdorf and Warterdorf before returning to Gleiming, using the wide "5-Huts-Hike" to return to the start.

Aberg Circular-Trail A4

Schladming 🕒 2:00 h ↔️ 5.8 km ⬆️ 205 vm ■ easy

A marvelous walking tour on the sunny side of Ennstal. On beautiful meadow paths with only a minimal climb, you will hike through the Pichl section of Schladming and the so-called "Grubdorf". There are so many things to marvel at aside from the surrounding mountain panorama – including the architecture of centuries-old farmhouses.



Tauernblick Circular-Trail C4

Schladming 🕒 4:30 h ↔️ 18.2 km ⬆️ 290 vm ■ easy

Taking your walk with the so-called River Enns, the Tauernblickrunde leads through forest and meadows, connecting Schladming with Pichl. North of the Enns, you hike along the edge of the forest through a part of town known as the Obere Klaus. At the bathing lake in Pichl, you will cross the Enns, then continue via the mostly paved Enns Cycle Path.

Enns Circular-Trail C4

Schladming 🕒 1:30 h ↔️ 6.1 km ⬆️ 25 vm ■ easy

This path brings you close to the river Enns. A mostly flat pathway takes you on a stroll from the Planal stadium in the direction of the congress centre Schladming, then to the right riverbank of the Enns. There, you can take a break and enjoy the sound of the rippling water before continuing your walk – always next to the Enns, of course.

Rohrmoos Circular-Trail C4

Schladming 🕒 2:15 h ↔️ 6.3 km ⬆️ 265 vm ■ easy

An opportunity to "circle" Rohrmoos, strolling through alpine meadows, forests, small villages and next to crystal-clear streams. The route takes you on forest and meadow paths, with a few shorter segments on paved footpaths. Many refreshment opportunities await you along the way. If you don't have that much time, you may opt for the "Weidenrunde" as a shorter option.

Katzenburg Circular-Trail C4

Schladming 🕒 3:00 h ↔️ 9.1 km ⬆️ 350 vm ■ moderate

This tour takes you to the ruins of the Katzenburg castle, where, according to legends, a treasure is hidden. On steep forest paths and wide trails, you will experience beautiful views of Schladming, Rohrmoos and the Scheichenspitzi-massif. You finally return to the starting point via forest- and meadow paths.

Vorberg Path-of-Reflection B3

Schladming 🕒 1:00 h ↔️ 2.7 km ⬆️ 115 vm ■ easy

Especially on hot summer days, this path will help you find the perfect way to cool down. From the hikers info portal at Vorberg-Steierhof, you will walk into an extensive forest on the southern side of the Halsebergr. Spruce and pine trees provide welcome shade here, whilst the benches next to the path invite you to enjoy the occasional break.

Vorberg Circular-Trail B3

Schladming 🕒 1:40 h ↔️ 5.2 km ⬆️ 130 vm ■ easy

This hike leads you to five of the most beautiful areas of alpine pastures on the Ramsau plateau. Beginning at Gasthof Edelbrunn, you will hike through meadows, fields and high forests. Tip: This hike can also be combined with the bus ("Dachstein Seilbahn"). Amid the alpine pastures, you will be greeted by multiple huts offering opportunities for rest and refreshments.

Panorama-Trail West B3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 3:30 h ↔️ 10.1 km ⬆️ 145 vm ■ easy

Almost flat, this scenic path leads through the western part of Ramsau. On a wide path, you will hike through meadows and fields, between maples and through forests. You will follow the stream and pass several farms. The easy tour is also navigable with a pram. For the Tannenweg, we recommend an all-terrain baby buggy.

Panorama-Trail East B3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 2:30 h ↔️ 7.8 km ⬆️ 150 vm ■ easy

The first stage leads across open meadows and is also suitable for prams/strollers as far as Pension Alpenhof/Feistner. After that, the occasionally narrow path winds its way through the forest. If you cross the road, you will come to the Hofrat Gruber Weg, a lane you can follow in the direction of Kulum, then continue via the Philosophenweg to the town of Ramsau.

Duregg Circular-Trail A3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 3:45 h ↔️ 9.4 km ⬆️ 520 vm ■ moderate

The Duregg Circular-Trail serves as an exciting gateway to the alpine pastures of Ramsau. From the toll gate on the Dachstein road, a secluded, though very beautiful hiking path takes you through forest up to an elevation of around 1700 metres. Awaiting you there are many alpine meadows and imposing views of the Dachstein.

Starlit places

You can discover a total of 6 star-viewing sites in the Schladming-Dachstein region. Three of them are located in Ramsau am Dachstein, on the Birnberg and in Aich, the others can be found on the "Hiking Center" map.

Alpine-Walk A2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:45 h ↔️ 4.2 km ⬆️ 175 vm ■ easy

This is a family-friendly hike. Awaiting you are gentle climbs, paths through forests and meadows, and a short dirt trail over exposed tree roots. With great lookout points and views, we particularly recommend the view from the World Cup ski jump, from where you can gaze across all of Ramsau Valley and the farms scattered across the plateau.

Philosopher's Path B3/C3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 0:30 h ↔️ 1.6 km ⬆️ 40 vm ■ easy

This family-friendly hike leads you around the Sattelberg, promising interesting experiences along the way. As you follow this occasionally narrow path through the trees, you will also pass a linen factory and an old mill and cross the rushing waters of the Ramsaubach, in part. The path becomes a hiking trail involving a moderately steep climb.

Kalvarienberg Circular-Trail Nr.9 D3

Haus 🕒 4:50 h ↔️ 3.0 km ⬆️ 120 vm ■ easy

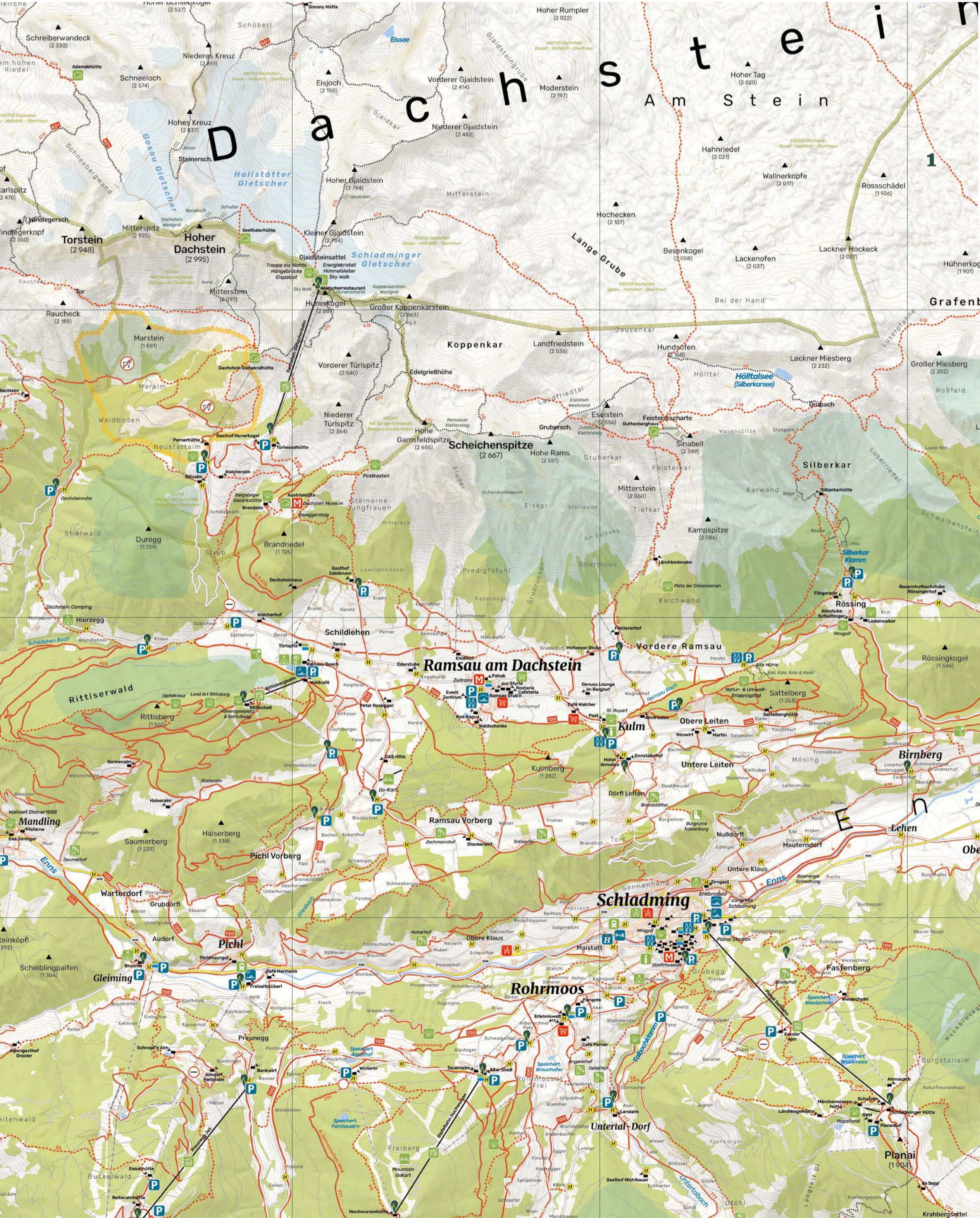
As a leisurely walk for "in-between", we recommend walking up the Calvary Path in Haus im Ennstal. Involving a moderate climb, you will start in the village centre of Haus, passing numerous beautifuly created altars as well as the delightful parish church of Haus im Ennstal, before reaching the top.

This easy hiking loop allows you to experience the sunny Birnberg plateau at its most beautiful. You will start at the village of Birnberg and hike along flat paths, bringing you past beautiful farmhouses as well as wonderfully maintained forests and meadows. With a bit of luck, you might even catch sight of an animal or two grazing peacefully.

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Hofrat-Gruber-Path C3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 0:40 h ↔️ 2.2 km ⬆️ 50 vm ■ easy

This walk leads you from Ramsau Kulm to the Old Mill. You will hike along a narrow, gently falling path, occasionally over exposed tree roots. You will be accompanied by the babbling waters of the Ramsaubach flowing next to you. With a little bit of luck, you might even see the Old Mill in action – it always operates on Fridays during the summer.

Leiten Circular-Trail C3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 1:50 h ↔️ 6.6 km ⬆️ 125 vm ■ easy

The Leiten Circular-Trail is a pleasant footpath leading through meadows and small patches of forest. This easy, attractive walk is family-friendly with only moderate changes in elevation and beautiful views of the Ennstal.

Sattelberg Circular-Trail C3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 3:00 h ↔️ 9.1 km ⬆️ 220 vm ■ easy

This family-friendly hike leads you around the Sattelberg, promising interesting experiences along the way. As you follow this occasionally narrow path through the trees, you will also pass a linen factory and an old mill and cross the rushing waters of the Ramsaubach, in part. The path becomes a hiking trail involving a moderately steep climb.

Birnberg Circular-Trail Nr.16 D3

Haus 🕒 0:45 h ↔️ 2.4 km ⬆️ 70 vm ■ easy

This easy hiking loop allows you to experience the sunny Birnberg plateau at its most beautiful. You will start at the village of Birnberg and hike along flat paths, bringing you past beautiful farmhouses as well as wonderfully maintained forests and meadows. With a bit of luck, you might even catch sight of an animal or two grazing peacefully.

Oberhaus Circular-Trail Nr.1 D3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 3:15 h ↔️ 10.1 km ⬆️ 320 vm ■ moderate

For everyone who wishes to explore their chosen holiday spot on foot, setting out from Haus village centre, your hike takes you on nicely maintained paths, moderately uphill, past the small village of Oberhaus and through Lehen. Finally, you will climb to the top of the sunny Birnberg plateau, where this tour comes to its glorious conclusion.

Gumpenberg Circular-Trail Nr.3 D3

Haus 🕒 3:30 h ↔️ 10.4 km ⬆️ 540 vm ■ moderate

This hike is ideal for families. Most of the time you are hiking at roughly 1000 meters altitude, with all paths rated "moderate". From Haus im Ennstal, you will hike through native flora to the top of the Gumpenberg. Make a side trip into Gumpental to enjoy a great view of the striking Hochstein.

Weissenbach-Burgstaller Circular-Trail Nr.15 B3

Haus 🕒 3:20 h ↔️ 10.9 km ⬆️ 370 vm ■ easy

An easy hike begins in Weissenbach, though it does require a certain degree of stamina. Climbing moderately, you will hike up to the sunny Birnberg plateau, returning to Weissenbach via forest paths and forestry lanes. One highlight of the tour is the "Burgstaller-Weissenbach" connecting path, treating you to views of the entire valley below.

Alpine-Tours

Torwanderung A2

Ramsau, Filzmoos 🕒 5:30 h ↔️ 13.2 km ⬆️ 970 vm ■ difficult

This tour brings you especially close to the Dachstein. First, you will hike through larch forest, then through open fields of scree, up to the "Tor", a natural gateway between the Rauchack and Torsstein. A brief "yet" steep downhill stage brings you past the south face of the Dachstein to the Südwandhütte, then via the Dachstein road back to the starting point.

Jungfrauensteig B2

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 4:00 h ↔️ 7.5 km ⬆️ 655 vm ■ moderate

This hike takes you through craggy terrain to the Steinerne Jungfrauen, a rock formation unique in Central Europe. Via a high-alpine path, you will continue to the Edelgessner, finally descending through mountain pine to the Austrühütte and Brandriedl. There, you will discover the Alpine Museum, a memorial to mountain climbers, and the Dachstein Chapel.



Guttenberghaus C3

Ramsau am Dachstein 🕒 4:30 h ↔️ 10.8 km ⬆️ 1015 vm ■ moderate

The Guttenberghaus is the highest refuge hut in Styria. The hike up takes you via a very steep pathway leading to the Lärchbodenaalm. Becoming increasingly rocky, you continue to hike uphill through pine trees and across the green mountainsides

The water plunges thunderously a total of 140 meters into the depths below. A 50-meter suspension footbridge is especially spectacular, taking you over the Riesachbach.

 The Robfeld nature path is an instructive walk for young and old, with numerous boards telling all about the region's flora and fauna. On a wide, easy pathway, you will hike a little downhill from the mountain station of the Hochwurzen summit lift, then uphill again to the Robfeld. Bench-Path: If you want to stay at the foot of the Robfeld, visit the Bench-Path with its 20 original benches. Allow 100m for the 2.3km circular route with 120 metres of altitude.
