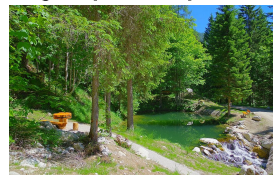
Museum of Literature - Altaussee

Sagtümpel - Tauplitz



The legendary Sagtümpel - one of Austria's rare Vaclusian giant karst springs - lies idyllically in the forest to the north-east of Tauplitz. The water rises from a deep spring lake from the bottom to the top and impresses with its changing flow and natural power. The spring used to be used to supply drinking water, but was renaturalized in 2017. Today, the Sagtümpel is a popular excursion destination and the 30 m high Tauplitz waterfall plunges into the Grimmingbach nearby - another natural highlight in the region.
