The Toplitzsee in the Totes Gebirge, surrounded by steep precipices and the Grundlsee, is famous for rumors of sunken treasures, including gold from the Third Reich. Weapons, explosives and forgeries were discovered after the Second World War. Speculation about the Amber Room and gold persists to this day. Relics are on display in the fisherman's hut.

Loser Panoramastraße

The Loser Panoramastraße in Altaussee is a 9 km long toll mountain road with magnificent views of the Ausseerland region. It leads up to 1,600 m above sea level and is also popular with cyclists and e-bikers. It is only accessible by car outside the operating hours of the Loser Panoramabahn. www.ausseerland.at/en/panoramicroad

The Tauplitzalm Alpine Road is a 10 km long toll mountain road from Bad Mitterndorf to 1,600 m above sea level, which impresses with magnificent views of the Ausseerland region. The Tauplitzalm is Europe's highest lake plateau and a popular excursion destination at any time of year.
